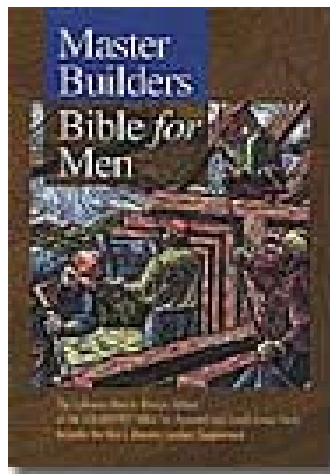
## Friday Night Options

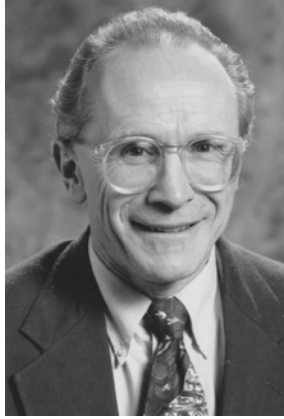

# Key Note Speaker

## Dr. Roland D. Martinson



Dr. Rollie Martinson is the Carrie Olson Baalson Professor of Children, Youth and Family Ministry at Luther Seminary in St. Paul, MN. He is a member of the National Council on Family Relations and author of a number of books, including *Effective Youth Ministry, A Congregational Approach* and *Coming of Age, Exploring the Identity and Spirituality of Younger Men*.

Ordained in 1968, he was pastor of Salem Lutheran Church in Glendale, Calif., until 1974, when he became pastor of Hope Lutheran Church in Fargo, N.D.

A summa cum laude graduate of Concordia College, Moorhead, MN, Martinson earned the B.D. degree from Luther Seminary in 1968. He received the S.T.D. degree from San Francisco Theological Seminary in 1978. He was scholar-in-residence at the Institute for Religion and Wholeness at Claremont, Calif. (1985-86), and attended the California Family Study Center in Burbank and The National Training Lab at Monterey while in the parish.

### The Program

A man's world is work, spouse, family and sports. There seems little time for anything else let alone God. Dr. Martinson will first explore, "Where is God in a Man's World?"

We live in a world created by God where man was created in the image of God and instructed to rule over that creation. In the afternoon presentation, "Where is Man in God's World?", Dr. Martinson will seek ways of tapping the critical gifts of men for ministry in the Church.
